Step 1: Fasten

NOTE: See intake screen quick install guide if intake screen was purchased before performing these steps.

Turn Float upside down

- Join Motor Mount to float with supplied fasteners.



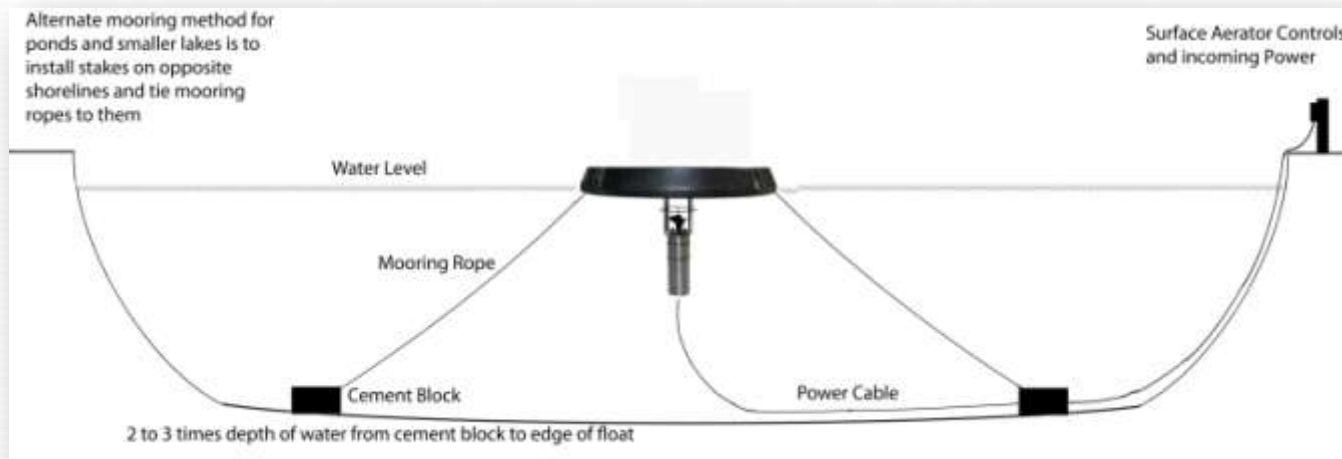
Step 2: Turn Upright

- Turn float over so it is upright. You are now ready to put it in the water.



Step 3: Mooring Aerator

- Bring aerator to desired location, tie mooring ropes to aerator float, and fasten ropes to shore or anchors.



Step 4: Connect Power

1. ½ HP 120 or 240 Volt Single Phase

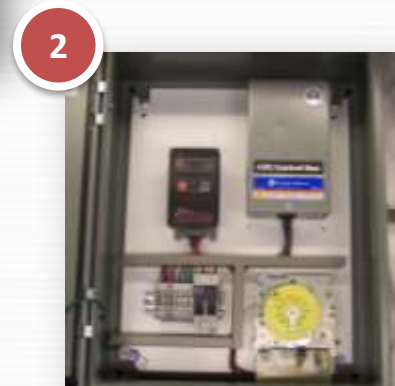
